

## Умовні речення (Conditionals)

### Zero Conditional (завжди істина):

If + Present Simple, Present Simple

If you heat water to 100°C, it boils.

### First Conditional (реальна майбутня умова):

If + Present Simple, Future Simple

If it rains, we will stay at home.

### Second Conditional (нереальна ситуація тепер/у майбутньому):

If + Past Simple, would + V

If I won the lottery, I would travel the world.

### Third Conditional (нереальна ситуація в минулому):

If + Past Perfect, would have + V3

If you had studied, you would have passed the exam.

### 2. Після сполучників часу (before, after, when, until, till, as soon as, if)

Після них майбутній час не вживається. Замість Future Simple ми використовуємо Present Simple, хоча дія має відбутися в майбутньому.

Приклади:

I'll call you when I **get** home.  (WRONG: when I will get)

Wait here until the train **comes**.

We'll eat after he **arrives**.

Before you **leave**, please close the window.

Call me as soon as you **arrive**.
