Great! Follow me... Let me look for a few menus and a little of bread.	<i>OK. How many time do we have to wait?</i>
Here you have...it may t ake some time to get your food because we are full. May I take your order?	<i>Well, tell me how much the red wine. Pasta for main course.</i>
The red wine is 9 dollars. I will ask if we have any bottles left. Anything else you need?	<i>Yes, add a lots of grated cheese to the pasta.</i>
Fantastic! Wait here a few minutes and I will bring your drinks!	<i>OK.</i>
Here you have your drinks... The chef says your order won't take much time. I will be right back.	<i>I hope so.</i>
