5. She said, "I love reading books."


6. Peter said, "I ate pizza for lunch."

→ She said that she loved reading books.

6. Peter said, "I ate pizza for lunch."

→ Peter said that he had eaten pizza for lunch.

7. The teacher said, "You did a great job."

→ The teacher said that I had done a great job.

8. My friend said, "I can swim very well."

→ My friend said that he could swim very well.

9. He said, "We watched a movie last night."

→ He said that they had watched a movie the night before.

10. Sarah said, "I am learning French."

→ Sarah said that she was learning French.
