A. Quick Review

- **Zero Conditional (general truths):**

If + present simple, present simple

If you press play, the movie starts.

- **First Conditional (real future):**

If + present simple, **will** + base verb

If I get the role, I will be happy.

- **Second Conditional (imaginary situations):**

If + past simple, **would** + base verb

If I were famous, I would direct a Marvel movie.

 Note: "Was" becomes "**were**" with "I" in formal English.
