## GRAMMAR FOCUS

### A. Quick Review

- **Zero Conditional (general truths):**

If + present simple, present simple

*If you press play, the movie starts.*

- **First Conditional (real future):**

If + present simple, **will** + base verb

*If I get the role, I will be happy.*

- **Second Conditional (imaginary situations):**

If + past simple, **would** + base verb

*If I were famous, I would direct a Marvel movie.*

 Note: "Was" becomes "**were**" with "I" in formal English.
