

Verb + -ing

After *avoid*, *can't stand*, *enjoy*, *finish*, *look forward to*, *(not) mind*, *miss*, *practise*, *stop* and after prepositions

I don't mind seeing your room.

She's tired after driving the whole night.

Verb + to-infinitive

After *agree*, *allow*, *ask*, *choose*, *decide*, *forget*, *hope*, *learn*, *need*, *offer*, *plan*, *remember*, *try*, *want*, *would like/love*

I'm trying to talk to Abe.

Verb + ing or to-infinitive

After *like*, *love*, *hate*, *prefer*, *start*

Do you prefer seeing/to see the beach?
