

Vienna is World's Most Liveable City

For the second year running, Vienna, the [redacted] of Austria, has been named the world's most livable city. Each year, the Economist Union Index (EUI) ranks 140 cities in the following categories: stability, healthcare, [redacted] and environment, education, and infrastructure. Some [redacted] that have done well in previous years, such as Paris, have struggled recently due to economic [redacted] and political unrest.
