

Trump Cancels Denmark Trip Because Greenland Is Not for Sale

President Trump cancelled his [redacted] trip to Denmark after the Danish prime minister told him that Greenland is not for sale. The US president had recently expressed interest in [redacted] the country. Greenland is an autonomous Danish territory located east of the Canadian Arctic.
