

Russia To Ban Smartphones for Military

Russia's parliament has [redacted] to ban the use of smartphones and social media [redacted] for military personnel. The purpose of the ban is to prevent [redacted] intelligence services from tracking military units and uncovering secret military information. Military personnel will not be allowed to [redacted] photos, videos, geolocation data, or personal updates while on duty. The new bill, which still needs full approval, also seeks to prevent Russian soldiers from writing about their military experience or talking to [redacted].
