

Seattle Airport Worker Steals and Crashes Plane

An airline worker at an international airport in Seattle, Washington stole a commercial over the weekend, taking it for an hour-long joyride before it into an in the Puget Sound. The Horizon Air employee was a ground service agent and admitted to an air traffic controller that he learned what he knew about flying from video games.
