First Conditional – for real or possible situations in the **present or future**

Form: *If + simple present, will + base verb*

Example: If it rains, we **will stay** inside.

Second Conditional – for unreal, unlikely, or imaginary situations in the **present or future**

Form: *If + simple past, would + base verb*

Example: If I had a car, I **would drive** to work.
