### Example Supporting Arguments

#### AGREE

- **Supporting Argument:** First of all, borrowing money changes people's attitudes and relationships.
- **Supporting Example:** For example, when I lent money to my friend, he suddenly became very nice and did things like holding the door open for me. I felt a little uncomfortable, and it changed our friendship a bit.

#### DISAGREE

- **Supporting Argument:** First of all, some people lend money to their family and friends without expecting to get the money back.
- **Supporting Example:** For example, when parents lend money to their children, they do it because they want to help their children. This can make children be grateful, and their relationships can be stronger.
