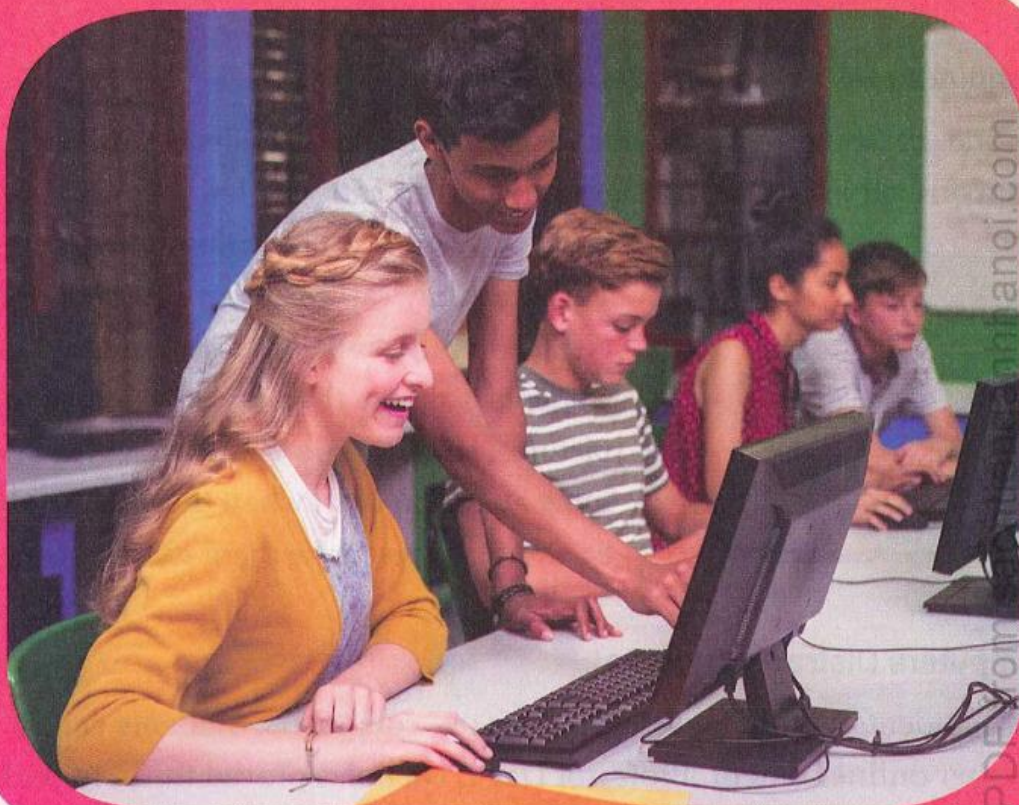

Computers Help Students Study Better

For one, computers give students access to lots of knowledge. Students can learn about any subjects online. For example, they can search for words they do not know, and they can get information very quickly. This way, they can easily get various information. Next, computers make learning more fun. They let students do more than just read. Students can use pictures, sounds, and videos to learn. Students pay more attention than when they just study only with books. This can make them want to learn more.



Computers Distract Students

First, students cannot focus when they use computers. Students can be distracted by other online content. Professor David Nicholas proved this. He studied students who learn with computers. He says their minds jump from topic to topic. They cannot focus on one topic for long. Second, computers do not help students to think critically. Derek Breen is a learning expert. He says that learning apps only help students memorize ideas. They do not improve students' critical thinking skills. They cannot teach students to think more deeply about a topic.
