


The charts below show the main reasons why students chose a particular university in the UK in 1997 and 2007.

4. By 2007, ranked **(last/ the last) (on/of)** the list was good sports and social activities, which was a factor for only 6% of students.
5. By 2007, **(of/in)** second **(place/list)** was proximity to home, with its figure rising to 22%.
6. In 1997, **(top/ at top)** of the list was suitable degree courses, with 35%.
7. In 1997, **(first/ the first) (on/of)** the list was suitable degree courses, with 35%.
8. **(Last/ The last) (on/of)** the list was proximity to home, with 10%.
9. In 1997, the quality of resources **(ranking/ ranked)** second **(on/of)** the list, with 21%.
10. By 2007, proximity to home **(ranking/ ranked)** second **(on/of)** the list, with 22%.
11. 14. **(Next/ The next)** came the quality of resources, with 21%.
12. 15. This was **(following/ followed)** by the quality of resources, with 21%.
13. In 1997, **(of/in)** first **(place/list)** was suitable degree courses, with 35%.
14. In 2007, ranked **(of/in)** first **(place/list)** was suitable degree courses, with 37%.
15. In 1997, ranked **(of/in)** second **(place/list)** was the quality of resources, at 21%.
