

VIRUSES: A CASE APART

1. Read this text and then tell whether each of the following statements is TRUE or FALSE:

Viruses are parasites that attack cells and cause diseases in living organisms.

A virus is much smaller than a cell. Indeed, it is a molecule encapsulated in a protein-based structure that carries genetic material.

Viruses are not made up of cells. For this reason, they are not considered living organisms.

In addition, viruses cannot perform any life processes by themselves: they need to infect a host cell and use its machinery to reproduce.

We classify viruses by their biochemical properties, reproductive mechanisms, and the type of cell they infect. Their system of classification is different from that of all living organisms.
