2. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a tall, narrow structure, often square or circular, that either forms part of a building or stands alone.
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a unit for measuring the volume of a liquid or a gas, equal to 1,000 cubic centimeters.
4. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a unit of length equal to 0.01 of a meter.
5. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a unit of measurement equal to 1,000 meters.
6. A \_\_\_\_\_ is someone who swims, especially in races, or someone who is swimming.
