William Faulkner was a Nobel Prize-winning American novelist and short story writer. He was born William Falkner on September 25, 1897, in Mississippi. When he was young he painted and wrote poetry. After the sixth grade, he began to write. He joined the British Air Force in 1918, but never went into battle. He went to university in 1919, but dropped out in 1920. Like most of his books, 'As I Lay Dying' is set in his home state of Mississippi. People say that along with Mark Twain and Truman Capote, Faulkner is one of the most important writers of Southern literature and one of the best-known writers in the history of American literature. He died in 1962.
