Hare: See you! Bye!

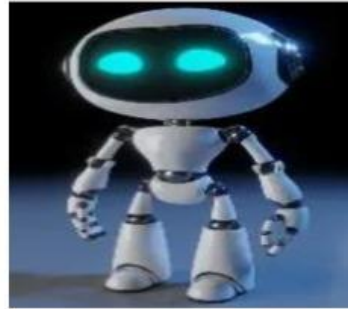
Turtle: Bye bye, Hare!
