This treaty was signed in Paris by James Monroe and Robert Livingston

Jefferson could make treaties, so he decided the purchase was okay in the form of a treaty

He owned Saint-Domingue (Haiti), but the Haitians rebelled for 10 years and won independence. He had to sell the Territory to pay for the war with Great Britain.

Jefferson sent James Monroe and Robert Livingston

People along the Mississippi River became farmers, and they needed the port of New Orleans to trade their goods

Napoleon Bonaparte wanted the Territory to form a Western Empire, and to control the West

To stop the war with France over the Louisiana territory and over control of American Trade
