a box that appears on your computer screen when the program you are using needs to ask you a question before it can continue to do something

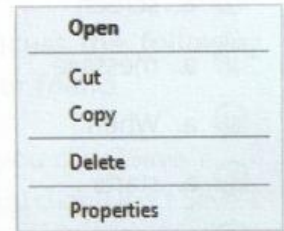
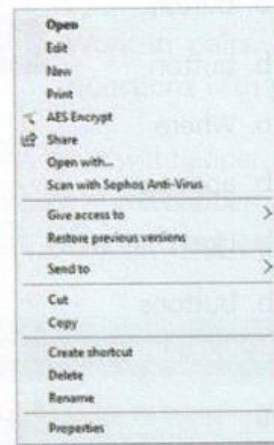
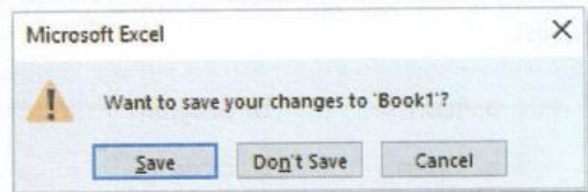
a small box that appears on a computer screen displaying information for the user and asking them to answer a question or make a choice

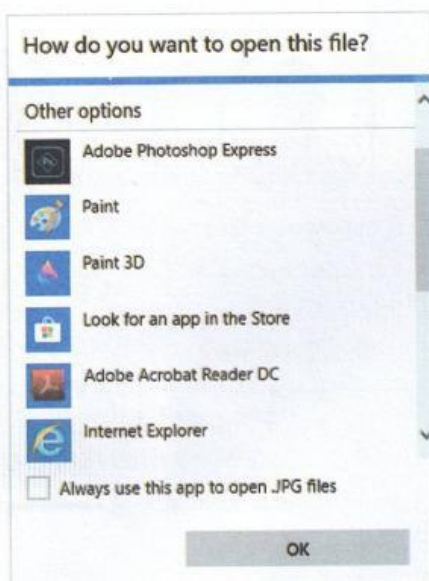

Dialog boxes are typically small, but the size depends on the amount of information. The dialog boxes can sometimes be large.

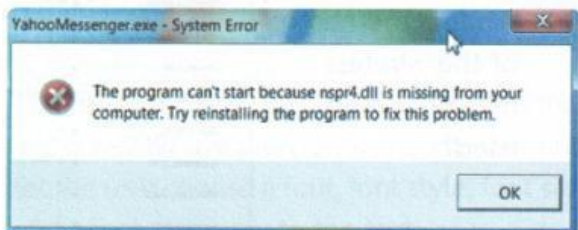


A dialog box that appears on a computer screen will ask the user to give information or choose what they want to do next.

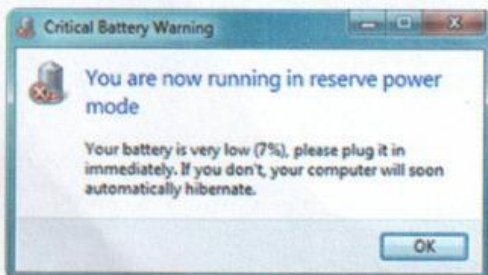
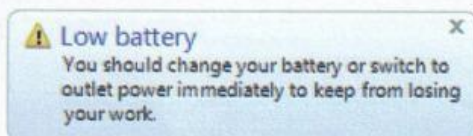
