4. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a long, usually hard seat for two or more people, often found in public places.
5. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a powerful, narrow beam of light that can be used as a tool to cut metal, to perform medical operations, or to create patterns of light for entertainment.
6. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a thin metal pin, used in sewing, that is pointed at one end and has a hole called an eye at the other end for thread.
