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Adverbs of frequency help us express how often an action happens. Here are some common adverbs of frequency

Adverbs of Frequency	Explanation	Examples
Always	100% of the time	She is always happy in the morning. I always eat breakfast before work.
Usually	More than 50% of the time	I usually go for a walk in the evening. We are usually busy on weekdays.
Often	A large part of the time	They often visit their grandparents on weekends.
Sometimes	Occasionally, not regularly	I sometimes forget my keys at home.
Rarely	Not often, a small part of the time	Eduardo is rarely absent from important events.
Never	0% of the time	Danny is never late.

Time Expressions to Express Frequency

Time expressions are phrases that help us indicate how often an action occurs. Using these expressions adds clarity to our communication. Here are some common time expressions to express frequency.

Time Expressions	Examples
Every day/week/month/year	I go for a run every morning .
Once a day/week/month/year	They visit their relatives once a month .
Twice a day/week/month/year	We have meetings twice a week .
Three times a day/week/ month/ year	She practices the piano three times a week .
Every other day/week/month/year	He works out every other day .
Daily /Weekly /Monthly /Yearly	We receive updates weekly .
In the morning / afternoon / evening	They have tea in the evening .
At night	I usually read a book at night .

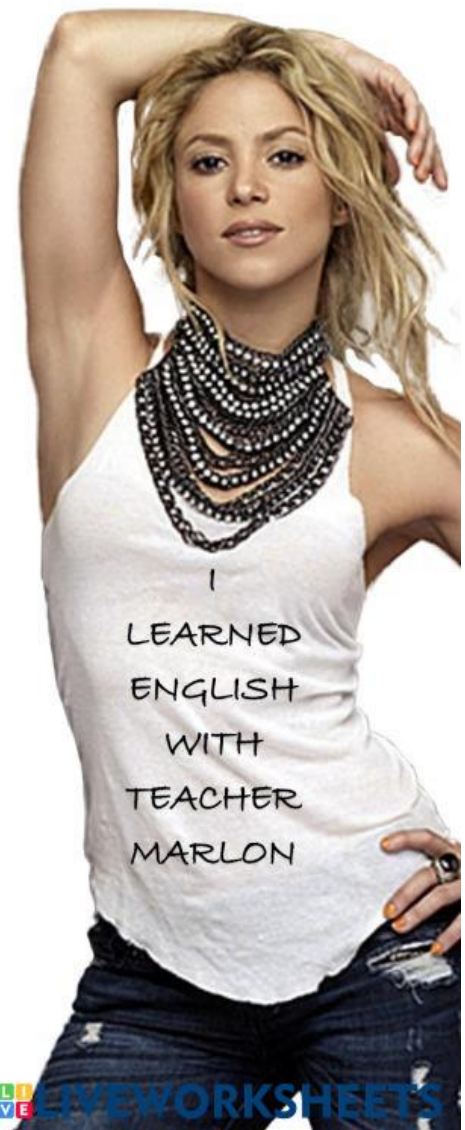

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Using Gerunds for Preferences: In English, we often use gerunds (verbs ending in -ing) to express likes, dislikes, and preferences related to hobbies and pastimes. Gerunds function as nouns in these cases. Some verbs use infinitives too. Here's a simple guide:

Example Verbs	Affirmative	Negative	Questions
Read	"I enjoy reading books."	"I don't like reading magazines."	"Do you like reading novels?"
Play (games)	"She likes playing video games."	"He doesn't enjoy playing sports."	"Do they play board games often?"
Swim	"We love swimming in the ocean."	"They don't like swimming in pools."	"Do you swim in the lake every summer?"
Cook	"He enjoys cooking new recipes."	"She doesn't like cooking with spices."	"Do you cook for yourself every day?"
Travel	"They like traveling to new places."	"I don't enjoy traveling alone."	"Does she travel abroad every year?"

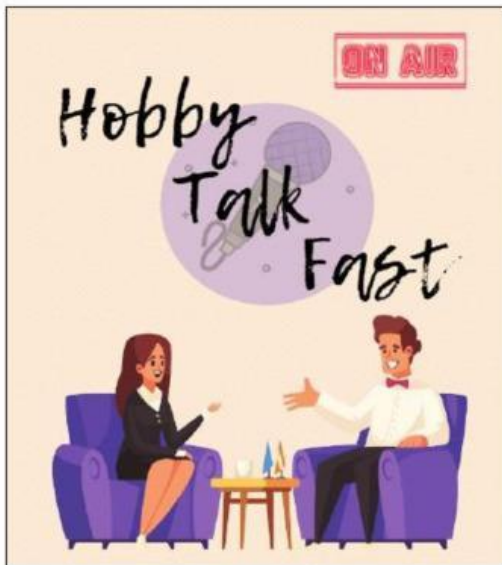
