



# Dreams vs reality

## EXPLORING THE PAST



- ★ Can you remember your last dream?
- ★ Was it a good dream or a nightmare?
- ★ Why is it memorable for you?

★ *In my dream, I baked a rainbow cake.*

We use **The Past Simple Tense** to talk about the main actions in your dream.

- ★ *I was baking a rainbow cake when the alarm rang.*

We use **The Past Continuous Tense** to show actions that were in progress when another action happened.
