Affirmative (+) S + V. Eg I drink coffee every morning.	S + V-s/es. Eg He drinks coffee every morning.
Negative (-) S + don't (do not) + V. Eg I don't drink coffee every morning.	S + doesn't (does not) + V. Eg He doesn't drink coffee every morning.
Interrogative (?) Do + S + V? - Yes, S + do. / No, S + don't (do not). Eg Do you drink coffee every morning? - Yes, I do. / No, I don't (do not).	Does + S + V? - Yes, S + does. / No, S + doesn't (do not). Eg Does he drink coffee every morning? - Yes, he does. / No, he doesn't (does not).
Interrogative Wh- (?) Wh- + do + S + V? Eg When do you drink coffee? What do you drink every morning?	Wh- + does + S + V? Eg When does he drink coffee? What does he drink every morning?
