Geopark Comarca Minera: more than just a park

The UNESCO Global Geopark Comarca Minera is part of the 161 territories in the list of Global Geoparks distributed in 44 countries. Geoparks are geographical areas that count with sites and landscapes of international significance.

The Geopark Comarca Minera consists of 31 geosites in 9 municipalities of Hidalgo: Atotonilco, Epazoyucan, Huasca de Ocampo, Mineral del Chico, Mineral de la Reforma, Mineral del Monte, Omitlán de Juárez, Pachuca de Soto and Singuilucan. The sites were selected because they express the geologic history of the territory and its relationship with culture, science and education. Besides, most of the sites count with an exceptional view of nature. Within the geosites of Comarca Minera you will find museums, hot spring spas, forests, geologic formations and historic sites that will give you a global view of Hidalgo.

Global Geoparks focus in promoting the importance of biodiversity and geological history by educating people on sustainability and other topics related. This project encourages the communities in the area to adopt a sustainable lifestyle that contributes to the conservation of natural resources for future generations. For this reason, in some of the geosites you will be able to find community gardens, compost, waste recycling or rainwater exploitation activities.

The Geopark also promotes responsible geotourism, which is a type of sustainable tourism that highlights geodiversity, biodiversity and heritage of a territory. In this way, visitors can interact with the landscape maintaining the balance between nature and economic development.
