

- **P:** Point (ý chính)
- **R:** Reason (lý do)
- **E:** Example (ví dụ)
- **P:** Point back (nhấn lại, tổng kết)

(= **Nêu ý – Giải thích – Ví dụ – Kết lại**)

1. PREP:

→ Nói thẳng quan điểm của bạn.

"Yes, I think so." / "Personally, I don't think it's very popular."

2. REASON:

→ Lý do tại sao bạn nghĩ như vậy.

"Because it's convenient and doesn't require commuting."

3. EXAMPLE (Ví dụ cụ thể):

→ Lấy ví dụ thật hoặc tưởng tượng.

"For example, during the pandemic, I took online English lessons and improved a lot."

4. POINT BACK (Kết lại – nhấn lại ý ban đầu):

→ Tóm gọn hoặc nhấn lại ý đã nói.

"So overall, I'd say it's a helpful way of learning."

“Have you ever learned anything on an online platform? ”

1. PREP:

"Yes, I have. I've taken quite a few online courses."

2. REASON:

"They are really convenient because I can study at my own pace and revisit lessons anytime."

3. EXAMPLE:

"For example, I took an English speaking course on a self-study website, and it helped me a lot with pronunciation and fluency."

4. POINT BACK:

"So I think learning through online platforms is really useful, especially for independent learners like me."

1. Have you ever learned anything on an online platform?

Yes I think online courses really come in handy. I took an English course on a self-study website and my English skills just improved in leaps and bounds.

- **come in handy (idiom):** trở nên hữu ích
→ "Online courses really come in handy." = Các khóa học online thật sự rất hữu ích.
- **self-study website (n):** trang web tự học
- **improve in leaps and bounds (idiom):** tiến bộ vượt bậc
→ "My English skills just improved in leaps and bounds."
- **Yes, I believe... / I guess so.** → để bắt đầu trả lời tự nhiên
- **Actually, I've had some experience with...**
- **One example is that... / For instance...**
- **To be more specific, I...** → dẫn chứng cụ thể
- "Yes, I've taken several online courses, especially during the pandemic."
- "To be honest, I find online platforms super convenient for language learning."

2. Is online learning popular in your country?

I don't think so. Although online learning allows us to study at our own pace, many people still think that it is better to attend traditional classes.

- **at our own pace (idiom/collocation):** theo tốc độ của riêng mình
→ "...allows us to study at our own pace."
- **traditional classes (n phrase):** lớp học truyền thống
- **attend (v):** tham gia, đi học (dùng với "class", "school"...)
- **I don't really think so, because...**
- **Although..., many people still...** → cấu trúc so sánh đối lập tự nhiên
- **It seems that... / From my observation...**
- "Well, it's getting more common, especially among young people."
- "But I think face-to-face classes are still more popular, especially in rural areas."

3. What are some advantages and disadvantages of online learning?

Well online learning is very convenient and flexible. We can study in our room at our own pace and probably still improve at a good pace. However, no face-to-face interaction may be a drawback, because students can't discuss the lessons or exchange ideas directly with their peers and teachers.

- **convenient and flexible (adj):** tiện lợi và linh hoạt
- **no face-to-face interaction:** không có sự tương tác trực tiếp
- **a drawback (n):** nhược điểm
- **exchange ideas (v phrase):** trao đổi ý tưởng
- **peers and teachers:** bạn học và giáo viên
- **On the one hand, ... / On the other hand, ...**
- **One major benefit is that...**
- **However, there's a downside, which is...**
- **A potential disadvantage is...**

- "I'd say it's great for people with busy schedules."
- "But on the flip side, it can be quite isolating without real-time interaction."
- "So it depends on the learner's preference and learning style."
