When we subtract 'zero' from any number, it left the same number as a remaining digit. Let's try some examples. One is done for you :

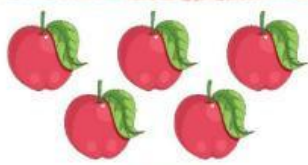

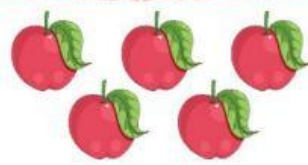
