We were at the cinema.	We weren't at the park.
You were at the cinema.	You weren't at the park.
They were at the cinema.	They weren't at the park.
there was / there were	there wasn't / there weren't
There was a problem.	There wasn't a problem.
There were some buses.	There weren't any buses.

wasn't = was not weren't = were not
