

Higher Understanding Music – Practise Questions

Question 8D

You will hear an excerpt from a piece of vocal music.

Below is a list of features that occur in the music.

There will now be a pause of 1 minute to allow you to read through the question.

The lyrics of the song are printed in the table on the opposite page. You should insert each feature once in the column on the right, at the point where it occurs.

You only need to **insert the underlined word**.

- SATB choir in Harmony
- Bassoon plays *for the first time*
- A Perfect Cadence is heard *for the first time*
- SATB choir in Unison
- Accompanied female voices only
