

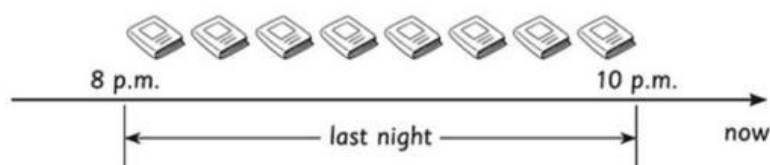
Past continuous tense (1)

- A: Guess what? I met Miss Cheung and her husband at Magic Shopping Centre last Sunday!
- B: Really? What **were** they **doing**? **Were** they **buying** clothes?
- A: No, they weren't. I met them in a cafe. I **was** **having** dessert and they **were** **drinking** coffee.



We usually use the **past continuous tense** for actions that continued for a period of time in the past.

What **were** you **doing** when I called you last night?
I **was** **reading** a book.



I / He / She / It + **was** + **-ing**

We / You / They + **were** + **-ing**
