

Past continuous tense (2) when

Mr and Mrs Lo were looking at the sharks
when Ken took a photo.



We use **when** to link a longer action and a shorter action in the past.

I saw a frog **when** I was jogging in the park.

I was jogging in the park **when** I saw a frog.

longer action – use the
past continuous tense

shorter action – use the
simple past tense
