

Elements of Poetry

Matching:

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| 1. Mood | A group of lines in a poem |
| 2. Stanza | Author of a poem |
| 3. Rhythm | Words that have the same ending sound |
| 4. Poet | Comparing two unlike things (NOT using "like" or "as") |
| 5. Line | Describes the beat, sound, and feel of a poem |
| 6. Rhyme | A genre that is written in stanzas and lines |
| 7. Theme | Language that appeals to the reader's sense of sight, hearing, touch, smell, and taste |
| 8. Imagery | The truth, lesson, or message about life in a poem |
| 9. Poetry | A poem that has a consistent rhyme and rhythm |
| 10. Metaphor | Repetition of a sound, syllable, word, phrase, line, or stanza |
| 11. Figurative Language | A poem that does not use consistent rhythm, rhyme, or any other musical pattern |
| 12. Repetition | Words or expressions whose meaning is different than the literal meaning |
| 13. Narrative Poem | A poem that tells a story: Beginning/Middle/End |
| 14. Lyrical Poem | A single row of words in a poem |
| 15. Free Verse Poem | Feeling of the poem |
