

Avoid accidents to children!

Dear Editor,

Recently I have read many stories in your newspaper about children having accidents. In my opinion, people could avoid many of these accidents. If we are more careful, we can easily reduce the number of accidents.

5 One example is the story I read last Saturday about a three-year-old girl. She burnt herself badly on a pan in the kitchen of her home. Her mother was not there. She was talking to a neighbour in the corridor when her daughter hurt herself. Mothers should keep their children with them and should not leave them alone with dangerous things.

10 Another example is the news story about a ten-year-old cyclist in Wan Chai. He was waiting at traffic lights when a taxi knocked him off his bike. The taxi driver did not see him because he was checking a text message on his phone. This is very careless. To make things worse, the boy was not wearing a helmet while he was cycling. When he fell, he hit his head on the ground. Fortunately a passer-by called an ambulance but the cyclist is still in hospital.
