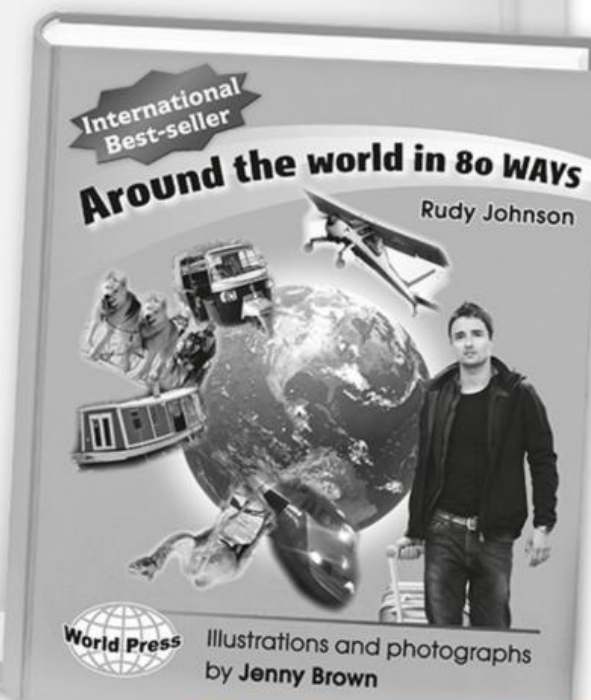
Although I don't usually enjoy travelling, I loved reading this travel book. I bought it for a friend but ended up keeping it for myself!
