| I | He • She • It | We • You • They |
| + I am ('m) Brazilian. | He is Brazilian. | We are Brazilian. |
| - I am not ('m not) from Poland. | She is not (isn't) from Poland. | You are not (aren't) from Poland. |
| ? Am I a student? Yes, I am./No, I am not ('m not). | Is it your address? Yes, it is./No, it is not (isn't). | Are they students? Yes, they are./No, they are not (aren't). |

| Subject pronouns | |
| I'm a student. | We're from Spain. |
| You are in my class. | You're sixteen. |
| He's a teacher. | |
| She's a new student. | They're French. |
| It is black. | |

Subject pronouns replace nouns:

Jo is seventeen. = He's seventeen.

Are Marie and Pierre from France? = Are they from France?

- No, he isn't he is Indian.
- No, they aren't are they Indian names?

6. You and your friend are sixteen. (fifteen)

- No, you isn't we are fifteen.
- No, we aren't you are fifteen.
- No, they aren't are you fifteen?

7. I'm a teacher. (student)

- o, you isn't you are a student.
- No, you aren't I am a student.
- No, he isn't are you a student?
