#### Subject pronouns, to be

	I	He • She • It	We • You • They
+	I am ('m) Brazilian.	He is Brazilian.	We are Brazilian.
-	I am not ('m not) from Poland.	She is not (isn't) from Poland.	You are not (aren't) from Poland.
?	Am I a student? Yes, I am./No, I am not ('m not).	Is it your address? Yes, it is./No, it is not (isn't).	Are they students? Yes, they are./ No, they are not (aren't).

#### GRAMMAR REFERENCES

#### Subject pronouns, to be Subject pronouns

I'm a student.	We're from Spain.
You are in my class.	You're sixteen.
He's a teacher.	They're French.
She's a new student.	
It is black.	

Subject pronouns replace nouns:

*Jo is seventeen. = He's seventeen.*

*Are Marie and Pierre from France? = Are they from France?*

I	am ('m)		I	am not ('m not)	
You/We/They	are ('re)	French.	You/We/They	are not (aren't)	from India.
He/She/It	is ('s)		He/She/It	is not (isn't)	

Questions			Short answers
Am	I		Yes, I am. No, I am not ('m not).
Are	you/we/they	16?	Yes, you/we/they are. No, you/we/they are not (aren't).
Is	he/she/it		Yes, he/she/it is. No, he/she/it is not (isn't).
