

Indefinite Article – A / An

Explanation:

We use "a" before words that begin with a consonant sound.

We use "an" before words that begin with a vowel sound (a, e, i, o, u).

Examples:

- 1. I have a cat.
- 2. She eats an apple.
- 3. We saw a movie.
