People have always enjoyed doing extreme sports, but they haven't always known about them. But recently, new sports have become very popular thanks to TV and video websites like YouTube. Only a few people do these sports, but they have made videos, and millions of people have watched them online.

FREERUNNING

Sebastien Foucan invented freerunning in 2003. People have made TV programmes about him, and the TV programmes have made the sport popular around the world.

People usually do Freerunning in a city centre. They move around the city by running, climbing and jumping on walls and buildings, as well as the ground.

In freerunning, it's important to look good, so freerunners try to find creative and challenging ways of moving. It's almost like dancing!

Freerunners need to be confident. You can't be nervous when you're running up a wall, and someone is making a video of you!



BASE JUMPING

In 1978, a filmmaker called Carl Boenish made a video of a friend jumping from the top of a mountain in Yosemite National Park in the USA. This was the first recorded BASE jump.



Today, BASE jumping is very popular, and BASE jumpers have jumped from bridges, cliffs, mountains, waterfalls, and even very tall buildings like the Petronas Towers in Malaysia. They use a parachute to land safely. BASE jumpers have made thousands of videos of their jumps. It's an extremely dangerous sport, but most BASE jumpers have jumped many times. When they jump, they feel scared, but very excited, so they want to do it again.
