

RULES OF SYLLOGISMS



NOT ALL

MOST

SOME = More than 1

FEW = less than 50%

ONLY

NO / NONE

MUST

COULD

MAY ALSO

ATLEAST



EITHER OR – strictly two options = Two outcomes ONLY (no third outcome possible)

EXCEPT

MOST COMMON THEMES IN UCAT

NEGATIVE NEGATIVE = e.g. not unimpressed ; not unwelcome; not unhappy

COMMON ROOT

COMMON DESTINATION

**READ DETAILS e.g Green Fuels in the stem- mentions Fuels in the stem
Developing Economies- talks about Economies**

SUBSTITUTION--- if cat was a dog; if Tim was Sim;

**ALL EXCEPT – e.g. All jars were filled with pebbles except the blue jar
e.g. All students studies UCAT except Joe**

**ELIGIBILITY ---e.g. All Apples that were green and red were from New Zealand
All Boys who were playing Basketball & Tennis were from school X.**

QUANTIFYING--



EXAMPLE --- arrow goes from Example e.g. Lobsters & XY are types of Marine Life.
ARROW GOES FROM LOBSTERS TO MARINE LIFE

ARE / IS RULE ---- arrow goes TOWARDS THE VARIABLE FOLLOWING the "are" word
e.g. All Toddlers are happy ; all boxes are blue ;
all water bottles are in plastic containers
