Benson Boone - Beautiful Things



Benson Boone is an American singer, songwriter, and multi-instrumentalist. He was born in Washington State in 2002 and discovered his love for music during high school. At first, he was more interested in sports and art, but everything changed when a friend asked him to perform in a school talent show. That performance made him realize he had a powerful voice and a passion for performing.

In 2021, Benson auditioned for the show **American Idol**. His voice impressed the judges immediately, and many believed he would go far in the competition. However, he decided to leave the show early, saying he wanted to grow as an artist outside of the spotlight. This unexpected choice didn't stop his career — in fact, it helped him find his own path.



Later that year, he signed a record deal and released his debut single, which quickly gained attention on social media. His emotional lyrics and honest style connected with young listeners around the world.



In 2024, Benson Boone gave one of the most iconic performances of his career at the **67th GRAMMY Awards**, singing "*Beautiful Things*" live. The performance was full of emotion, and many fans and



critics called it one of the highlights of the night. It showed not only his vocal talent but also his authenticity and stage presence.

Benson Boone is now considered one of the most promising new voices in pop music. With his talent and determination, he's just getting started.
