

CAN / CAN'T

We use **CAN** to talk about abilities (what people can / can't do). Eg: I **can** play the guitar.
She **can** play soccer.

AFFIRMATIVE:

Subject + **CAN** + Verb

Eg: They **can** run very fast.

NEGATIVE:

Subject + **CANNOT** + Verb (can't)

Eg: He **can't** play the piano.

INTERROGATIVE:

CAN + Subject + Verb

Eg: **Can** you ride a bike?
