Facts and routines	Actions happening now or around now
She walks to school every day. It rains a lot in April.	She is walking to school right now . It is raining today.

 **Signal words:**

- **Present Simple:** always, usually, often, never, every day
- **Present Continuous:** now, right now, at the moment, currently
