





They **catch** the bus.

**Negative**

I **don't** walk to school.  
He **doesn't** ride his bike.  
We **don't** catch the bus.  
They **don't** walk.

I walk to school.  
I don't catch the bus.

**Questions**

Do you **ride** your bike to school?  
Do they **catch** the bus to school?  
Does she **walk** to school?

**Short answers**

Yes, I **do**. No, I **don't**.  
Yes, they **do**. No, they **don't**.  
Yes, she **does**. No, she **doesn't**.




