


## Exercises Verb To HAVE



Ejercicio 1: Completa con "have" o "has" (afirmativo)

1. She \_\_\_\_\_ a new car.
2. I \_\_\_\_\_ two brothers.

5. We \_\_\_\_\_ a test tomorrow.

Ejercicio 2: Convierte a negativa (usa don't/doesn't + have)

Ejemplo:

Afirmativa: I have a cat. → Negativa: I don't have a cat.

Ejercicio 3: Convierte a interrogativa (Do/Does + sujeto + have...?)

Ejemplo:

Afirmativa: You have a dog. → Interrogativa: Do you have a dog?
