 - Preventing and addressing disruptive behaviour constructively.
 - Using positive reinforcement, redirection, and restorative practices.
6. _____
 - Incorporating interactive methods, maintaining active participation and motivation.
 - Differentiating tasks to match students’ interests and abilities.

 - Arranging layout to facilitate learning and supervision.
 - Organizing the online learning environment (platform structure, navigation).

 - Observing students’ participation and understanding.
 - Providing timely, constructive feedback on both behaviour and learning progress.
