 C Yes, that's correct.

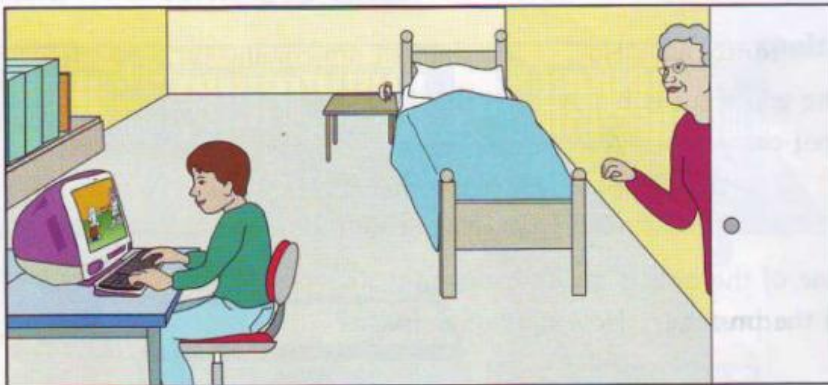
6 **Sue:** Which day do you want to come?

 - C Yes, it does.

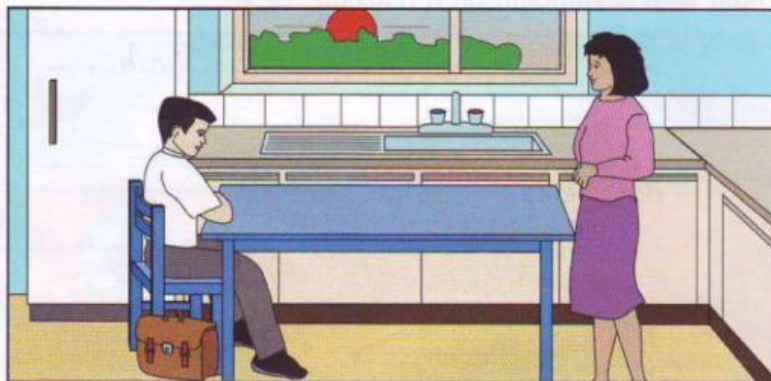
6 **Grandmother:** Now, which is your friend's house?
