

FILM REVIEW: THE LORD OF THE RINGS



This is an epic fantasy adventure trilogy of films directed by Peter Jackson. It is about a Hobbit called Frodo who is accompanied by eight companions on a journey to destroy a powerful ring and stop the Dark Lord Sauron from conquering the world. During his journey, he faces many challenges, meets incredible people, loses friends and hope, but his loyal friend Sam always supports him.
