In Australia, most children eat their lunch at school. Some bring sandwiches, fruit, and snacks from home, while others buy food from the school canteen. But what kind of food do they eat?

Many schools in Australia are trying to make lunch healthier. They don't sell sugary drinks or chocolate bars anymore. Instead, students can buy fresh salads, wraps, fruit, and yoghurt. Some schools also give lessons about healthy eating and why it's important.

At Green Valley Primary School in Sydney, the canteen cooks fresh meals every day. They use vegetables from the school's own garden and get fresh bread from a local bakery. Every week, students help in the garden and learn how to grow healthy food. The school also has "tasting days" where children can try new fruits and vegetables.
