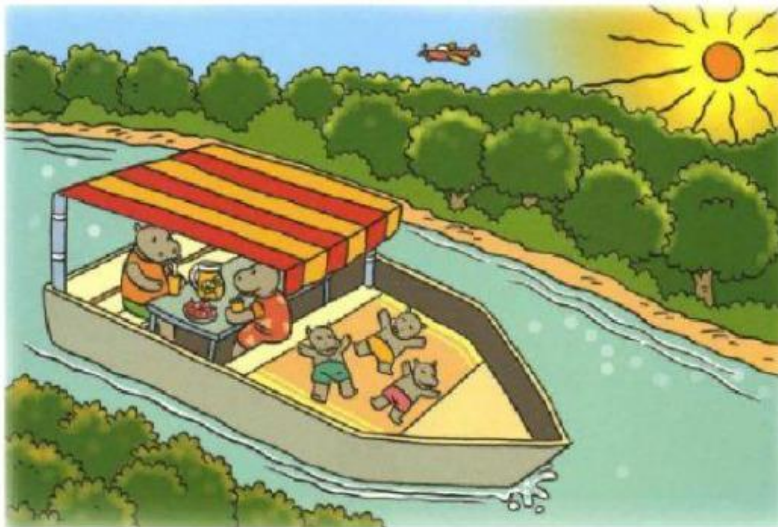
Bill is my good friend. He likes spiders and football. We play football at the weekends. Pasta is Bill's favourite food. Sometimes, he invites me to his house for pasta.
