Spelling Rules: Verbs ending in -e drop e and add -ing e.g. write – writing / ride – riding / make – making

Verbs ending with one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant e.g. swim – swimming / sit – sitting

Use: We use the Present Continuous to talk about actions happening at the moment.

Time Words: now / at the moment / right now

e.g. → We're studying English at the moment. → Look! Bob is coming home.


